## Friendship Scheme

How the Friendship Scheme works; All new tenants are asked if they wish to be part of the scheme when they complete their new tenant form by indicating YES or NO on the form. There is no obligation to join the scheme and it doesn't in any way affect your application; it is only beneficial to yourself and just another service that we offer to make LEA Property Solutions unique. If an existing/new tenant opts in then they will be asked to provide the following details which will then be added to the database which will then issued to all future tenants who take up residency in our properties; name, age, job title and email address.

Tenants won't be required to give out home addresses or phone numbers, any initial contact can be made through email and from then on it's up to the tenant. Please note that ONLY tenants that take up residency in our properties will have access to the database and these tenants have been personally vetted by us and have had references taken to check their suitability. It is a scheme that could seriously enhance your social life!

Just to reiterate, ONLY existing/new tenants who have opted in to this scheme will have their details entered on the Friendship Scheme database. For new tenants that say 'NO' on their new tenant form, they WILL NOT be included in the scheme. We understand this scheme won't suit everyone so please ensure you say 'YES' on your new tenant form when asked if you would like to part of the Friendship Scheme if you would like to take advance of the scheme.

Your details will automatically be removed from the database on the date that your tenancy ends and you vacate your room.
